- On weekends and holidays, 9 hole play is allowed after 4:00 pm only.
- Shotgun tournaments require a minimum of 120 players and commence at 7:00am/8:00 am
- Payment is due in full on the day of the tournament

Pace of Play

Golfers are asked to keep up with the group ahead of them.

For shotgun tournaments, a maximum 5.5 hour round is expected. For tee time tournaments, a maximum 4.5 hour round is expected.

Course Marshals will monitor slow play. Slow groups may be asked to pick up their ball and catch up to the group ahead of them.

Damages

Meadowview Golf & Country Club &/or Trestle's Edge Inc. will not be held responsible for loss or injury suffered or incurred by any guests.

The tournament host is responsible for any damages to power carts, the golf course, the clubhouse, or any fixed property of the golf course. Any lost or damaged rental clubs will be charged to the tournament host.

All signage, banners, etc. must be picked up immediately after the event. The golf course is not responsible for any lost or damaged tournament signage.

Alcohol Policy

The alcohol policy follows the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission guidelines.

All alcohol used or consumed on the premises must be purchased from the Meadowview Grill. Any outside alcohol will be confiscated and playing privileges may be revoked.

Tournaments wishing to host an alcohol hole must purchase the alcohol from the Meadowview Grill. Pricing and options can be arranged with the Restaurant Manager.

Beverage tickets are also available on request.

As per AGLC guidelines, only one liquor hole per 9 holes is allowed.

The Meadowview Grill requires 14 day notice for the purchase of any alcohol needed for these holes.
